


1. At the top of every site on SunGard Central, you'll find a "Share" and "Follow" button. Use these buttons when you want to share and/or follow sites, tags, documents, people and more>




2. Are you a frequent visitor to a certain site? Follow it, and keep track of everything you follow by visiting your "My Site" page. A handy tracker appears in the top right hand corner of the page.


3. Sharing a website with someone is another way to invite them to contribute to a particular discussion or website. Keep in mind, they must have permission to contribute to the site before using this feature.




4. You can also keep track of colleagues you mention in your online discussions and the discussions you are mentioned in by visiting My Site > Newsfeed...



...and then by clicking on "Mentions".



5. This will direct you to your Newsfeed where you can view all of the discussions in which you were mentioned.



6. Likewise, you can mention colleagues in your disucssions by using the following: @Firstname Lastname.



7. If you want to mention something or someone in particular in a conversation, you can also use the hashtag technique. In the example below, the story invites you to discuss the 2015 Coder Cup in conversations by using #SCCoderCup before your response.
